



This survey was conducted from December 15 - 19, 2021 and included a pool of 500 registered voters in Oklahoma. These survey results were weighted based on age, gender, party affiliation, level of education and race. This survey has a margin of error of 4.38% at a 95% confidence interval. The poll surveyed both cell phones and landlines and used a combination of live callers and an online panel of likely voters.
